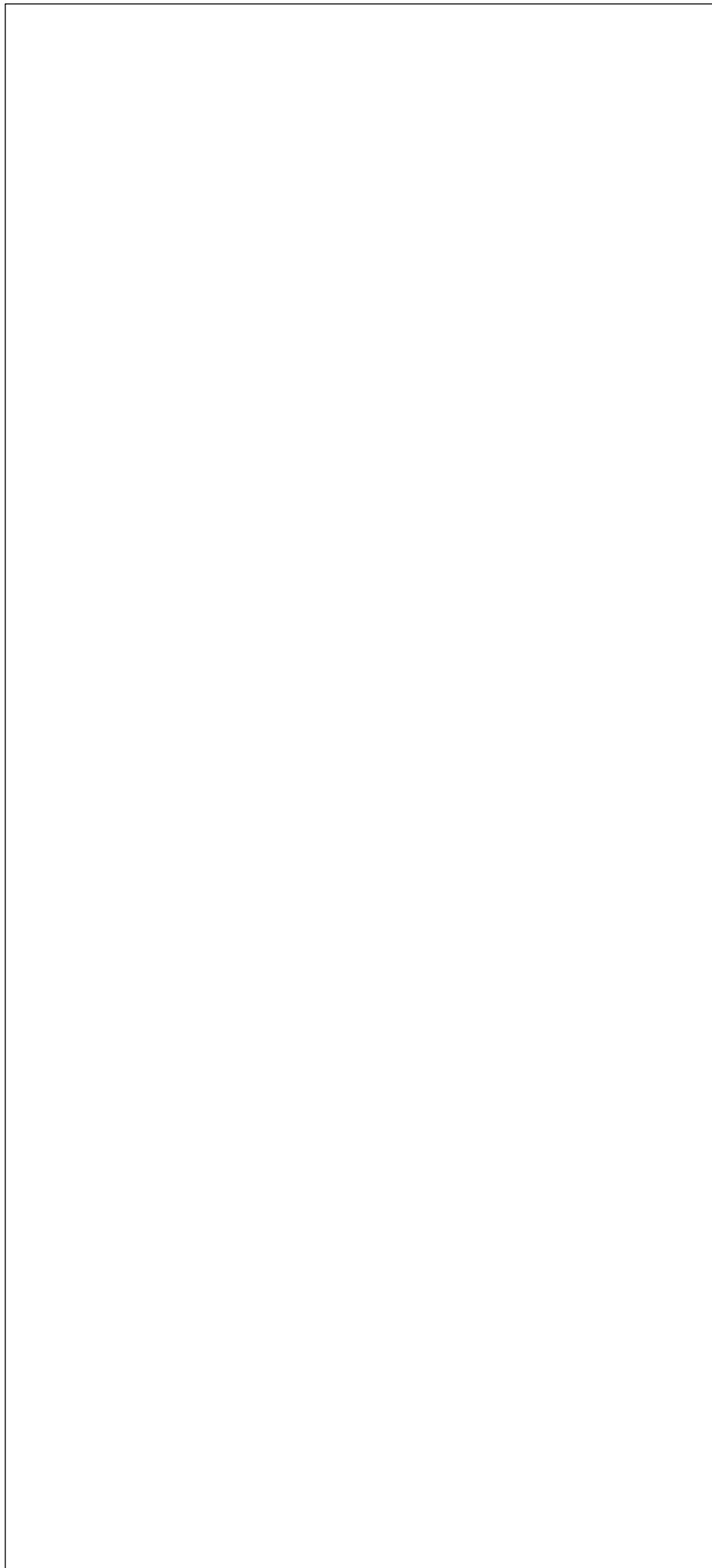
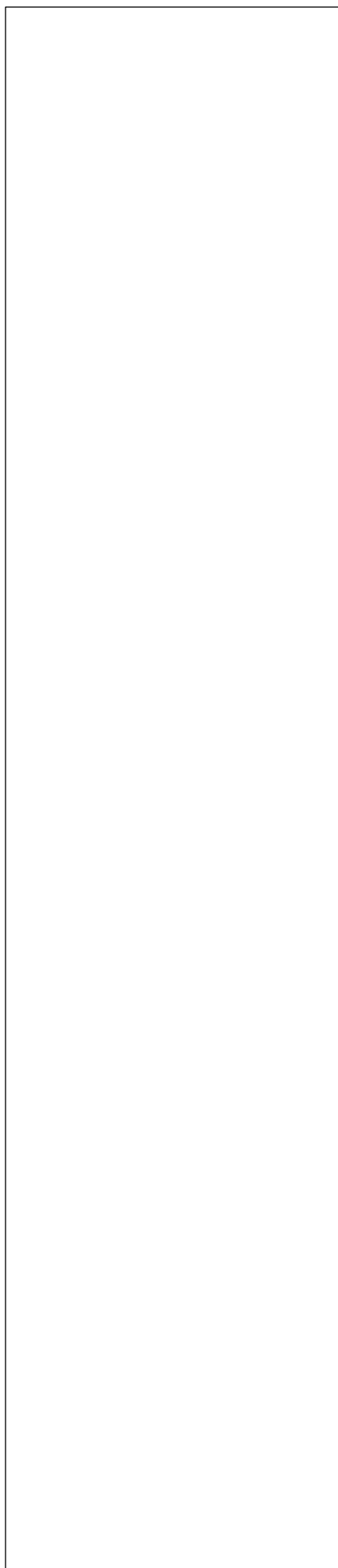
Games, raffle, hotdogs & chips, cakes, face-painting, ice creams, performances, tambola and alcoholic fruit punch (for the adults!)
