Make it funny for your reader. <i>Children could use a horrible histories book as an example of funny description writing.</i>	Can you create a new dragon and dragon rider? Draw and describe your dragon and their rider using a range of writing structures used in class. <i>Please use the writing mats included as a prompt and support for writing.</i>	Create a brochure to advertise the 'Island of Berk' as a holiday destination for tourists. Evaluate whether you think it is a safe place to visit. Design your brochure to present the positives or negatives of the island.
I enjoy maths (must complete at least one activity from this row)	Complete a 12 x 12 multiplication square on your own.	How many different ways can you calculate the number 100? Show your working out using a range of strategies and methods that you know.	Can you show how the long or short written multiplication is completed and explain how it works? Create a step by step guide showing how to use the method.	Make a poster for a younger pupil explaining what a multiple, factor, prime, square and cube is. Make it colourful and most of all memorable. <i>Children could use the poster template included, or design one of their own.</i>	Can you plan and work out the prices of a healthy picnic and make it? Take a photo of you enjoying it! Try and work out how much more of each ingredient you might need for extra guests e.g. to feed ten, six or three people etc.

Would you prefer to live in Italy or the UK? Create a comparison poster, booklet or picture and discuss which place appeals to you the most.	Can you design and make a three course Italian meal for under £10? Choose healthy ingredients and measure quantities you need to feed everyone. What did it taste like? Take a photo of your meal to put in your home learning book.	Find out about Leonardo da Vinci's plans to make a flying machine. What do you think of it and do you think it would work or not? Why?
