Show your warking out using a range of strategies and methods that you know.	Can you show how the long or short written multiplication is completed and explain how it works? Create a step by step guide showing how to use the method.	Make a poster for a younger pupil explaining what a multiple, factor, prime, square and cube is. Make it colourful and most of all memorable. Children could use the poster template included, or design one of their own.	Can you plan and work out the prices of a healthy picnic and make it? Take a photo of you enjoying it! Try and work out how much more of each ingredient you might need for extra guests e.g. to feed ten, six or three people etc.
