Please come along for a coffee and biscuits, it would be great to see some new faces! And of course the 'regulars'!

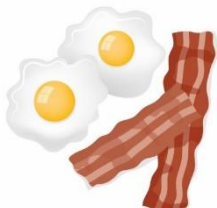


Thank You
