Use of Technology from Home

A decision has been taken that children will not be able to bring any technology for reward days or on school trips and residentials. They can bring a mobile phone to school but this must be handed in and collected at the end of the day.

Coming soon: Online payments to school with ParentPay!

Starting September 2017, we will be introducing a more convenient way to pay for school meals, trips, nursery snack and nursery top-ups, using a secure service called ParentPay.

ParentPay will go live on Friday 1st September; from this date we will be working towards no longer accepting cash and cheque payments, making the school a cash-free environment. Parents who need to continue making payments by cash may do so using the PayPoint network at local convenience stores.

ParentPay offers you the freedom to make payments whenever and wherever you like, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week - safe in the knowledge that the technology used is of the highest internet security available.

You will have a secure online account, activated using a unique username and password; you will be prompted to change these, and to keep them safe and secure. If you have more than one child at our school, or children at other ParentPay schools, you can create a single account login for all your children.

Making a payment is straightforward and ParentPay holds a payment history for you to view at a later date; no card details are stored in any part of the system. Once you have activated your account you can make online payments straight away.

We hope you will support us in achieving our goal to become a cashless school. Your support in using ParentPay will help the school enormously and you will receive your unique ParentPay account activation before the end of term.
