Teesh Shoe Boxes

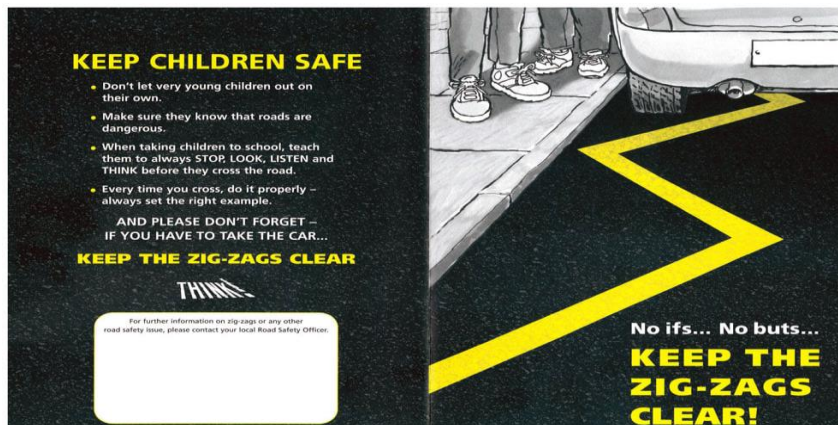
