Performance

Just to remind you that the performances of the Year 5 and 6 play, 'Alice the Musical', will take place in the Edgcombe Theatre at Devonport High School for Boys on Tuesday 10th July. There will be a morning performance at 10am and an afternoon performance at 1.30pm. Each will last approximately 1 1/2 hours. There is plenty of space in the theatre so there is no need for tickets and you are welcome to come along to both if you wish!

On both Monday 9th (for dress rehearsal) and Tuesday 10th July (for performances), we will be based at DHSB all day. This will mean that all children will need a packed lunch on both of these days, including plenty to drink and snacks for the day. If your child is entitled to free school meals a school packed lunch will be provided for them.

Sports Day

Sports day for Years 1 - 6 will be on Tuesday 17th July and will be held on the sports field at Stoke Damerel Community College, weather permitting. Please use the back entrance on Raynham Road to gain entry into Stoke Damerel. It will be starting at 9.30am and will be finished in time for the children to be taken back to school for lunch.

Sports Day will be the same format to previous years and will be a series of athletic events taking place at the same time with classes moving around each of the events in turn. There will be areas for parents to sit and watch each event and parents are able to move on with their child's class as they move around the field. Can parents please refrain from approaching the children, as our priority is to keep the children safe and this becomes tricky when we don't have their full attention.

Can parents please ensure that children have had sun cream applied before coming to school; have their full PE kits, appropriate footwear, sun hats and water bottles on the day. Children will be getting changed in school and will then be walked up to the college by school staff.

Yr 6 OAA Day

Year 6 will be going to Mount Edgcombe on Thursday 12th July. This forms part of our outdoor physical education programme that is run by Stoke Damerel Community College. All children will require a packed lunch and plenty to drink. The children can wear mufti but should take a school jumper so they can be easily recognised.
