Logging into Microsoft Teams on Kindle Fire

It's possible to install the Google Play store on a Kindle, and to then install Teams. It is unfortunately not easy, but on the bright side the following steps will allow you to install any Android app on the play store on your device.

1. Follow "Option One" this tutorial to get the Google Play Store installed: https://www.howtogeek.com/232726/how-to-install-the-google-play-store-on-your-amazon-fire-tablet/

A few important tips to keep in mind while following this tutorial:

- Make sure you are logged in with an admin account don't do this while logged in as your child. Microsoft Teams can only be used under and admin/parent user on the Kindle device.
- Make sure to go to Settings->Security & Privacy and then under Privacy select to allow "apps from unknown sources"
- Very important: When you are installing the four-play store APKs that they have you download, make sure you install them in the order they asked you to download them in. So first the file that starts with <u>com.google.android</u>.gsf.login, then the one that starts with <u>com.google.android</u>.gsf, then <u>com.google.android</u>.gms, then <u>com.android</u>.vending
- **2.** Once you have Google Play installed, you should launch the store, and login with a google account.
- 3. **Search within Google Play** for Microsoft teams in the play store: https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.microsoft.teams&hl=en_US

Note: When Microsoft Teams is launched the first time, it might prompt you to update Google Play. It will lead you back to reopen Google Play and hit an Update button. After you update, you will then be able to open Microsoft Teams will no issues.
