Merit Awards

In response to feedback we have made some changes to our merit award system for the new term. Now, over the course of an 'old' term (approximately every 12 weeks), each child will receive a merit certificate when they have earned the following tokens:

Bronze Award – 50 tokens earned Silver Award – 100 tokens earned Gold Award – 150 tokens earned Platinum Award – 250 tokens earned

These merit awards will be given out as the children earn them, and will be presented during our Monday 'achievement' assemblies. This new system will mean that each child can potentially earn all four certificates over the course of a term. After each long holiday (Christmas, Easter and the summer holiday) the token count will reset and the children will start to work towards a new set of awards. As an extra incentive we have told the children that if they earn a Platinum Award each term they will earn a special Chocolate Award at the end of the year.

We would like to take the opportunity to remind you that tokens are awarded for your child's efforts with their learning and are not awarded for behavioural reasons.
