Dear Parents/ Carers,

After yesterday's announcement by the Prime Minister we have been working hard to ensure that every child is able to continue with their education throughout this lockdown.

Here is the plan for your child's remote learning for the next six weeks.

For children that can access online learning the class teacher will post the lessons for the day each morning on Microsoft Teams. The children will be expected to complete this and return to the teacher for them to comment on the work.

The teacher will be online during the day so can be messaged by children if they are finding the work difficult.

For children who have no access to online learning we will produce a learning pack for each child. On Friday, a weekly pack of work will be left in the gazebo for you to collect (from 12noon onwards). This will include:

5 maths activities

5 English activities

5 Reading activities (phonics for EYFS and Key Stage I).

I science/ topic activities

I PSHE (personal, social, health education) activity

A book has been provided so your child can record their science, topic and PHSE work. We will mark this work at February half-term.

At the same time as collecting work, please ensure you drop off the previous week's English, Reading and Maths work. That way, we can offer feedback to your child via email. It is vitally important for your child to complete this work and receive feedback about how to improve further and maintain progress. In addition to the weekly work packs, you will be emailed maths video links and PowerPoint presentations to support the activities.

We are determined to ensure your child makes the best possible progress during this unfortunate period of school closure. Please continue to support us in making this happen.
